UMC 771 et al Permits

Tentative approval signed by Jim Smith is dated December 11, 1981.

A letter dated March 15, 1983 from Jim Smith of the Division gives approval for the loading system structure at the raw coal storage area.

A letter dated April 21, 1983 from the Division gives approval of the modification to the drainage control system.

A letter for the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) dated July 26, 1983 gives approval and acknowledgement for the abandonment of temporary refuse fill area #1 (Id # 1211-UT-9-0033).

The entrance sign was posted as required with all pertinent information listed. Perimeter markers were sighted along the boundary on all sides.

UMC 817.21-25 Topsoil

The topsoil stockpile received spot seeding last fall from their hydromulching operation. Some seedlings are coming up although it is too early to tell what kind of success is expected.

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
UMC 817.41-57 Hydrologic Balance

Ditches and berms were functioning as designed. No problems with sediment ponds were noted either. Some water was recycling through the plant but in general this plant is not running due to run of mine contracts. No runoff was noted at this time.

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UMC 817.52 Hydrologic Balance: Monitoring

CV Spur NPDES permit #UT-0023949 has an expiration date of December 31, 1986. The receiving water is the Price River. No water problems were noted in the data.
