A partial inspection of the above mentioned mine site was conducted on February 7, 1984. The inspector was accompanied by Dan Guy of the Beaver Creek Coal Company

At the time of this inspection the plant was still not operating due to run-of-mine contracts. The facility is still used as a load out, scale operation

All the sediment ponds were functioning as well as ditch and berms. The north east perimeter was walked to view the parrallel drainage ditches with no problems evident.

The only potential problem of concern is the ponding of melted snow water. The area is so flat that water tends to stand in depression rather than run. This plays havoc on access roads.
