Dear Mr. Braxton:

Enclosed are eight (8) copies of a proposed amendment to the C.V. Spur M.R.P. concerning sediment pond markers and cleanout levels. This amendment will propose to use quarterly surveys to determine sediment cleanout levels in the ponds, as opposed to sediment markers. Sediment markers have been used at C.V. Spur; however, with the recirculating nature of the system and the ground water levels in some of the ponds, they were not always visible and thus largely ineffective.

This change will provide for direct survey measurements of the sediment level in relation to the overflow of each pond. The results of the survey will be kept on file in the office.

The additional page is numbered, and should be added to the M.R.P. In addition, Plate 7-4A should be deleted from the plan.
