Dear Mr. Braxton:

Beaver Creek Coal Company submitted a proposed amendment to the typical cross-section on the C.V. Spur collection ditches on 9/15/87. Subsequent to that submittal, we had an O.S.M. oversight inspection on 10/8 and 10/9 1987, which resulted in the issuance of 8 T.D.N.'s.

On 10/21/87, I submitted additional information on the collection ditches in response to T.D.N. #6. This information was based on 10/20/87 conversations with Mr. Jim Frickie, and represented his recommendations at that time.

On 10/30/87, I received a letter from Mr. Hedberg concerning our original submittal, and indicating it could not be approved as proposed. I did not respond to this letter, since the plan had been changed (and apparently approved) with the response to the T.D.N.'s. (See my letter to you on 12/10/87).

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I have now been informed that this original amendment and disapproval is still an outstanding concern. In order to clear this issue, I propose the following course of action:

- (1) Consider this letter a formal request by Beaver Creek Coal Company to withdraw the proposed amendment dated 9/15/87; and,
- (2) Accept the 10/21/87 response to T.D.N. #6 as the approved amendment on the collection ditches. This is the way my records show the situation, although I have never received a formal approval (or disapproval) on T.D.N. #6.

I hope this proposal will help clear up this outstanding issue. If you have any questions, or need any further information, please let me know.
