Dear Mr. Smith:

Beaver Creek Coal Company is hereby applying for renewal of the Mining and Reclamation Permit No. ACT/007/022 for its Castle Valley Spur Coal Processing and Loadout Facility. This application is submitted in accordance with the provisions of UMC 788.13 through 788.15.

It should be noted that no major permit changes have occurred since the issuance of the original permit in August, 1984, or the subsequent Mid-term review and approval in April, 1987. Minor changes and other required information are enclosed, in accordance with the following listed provisions of UMC 788.14:

(a) Contents: Updated copies of all revisions or amendments to the plan have recently been submitted for inclusion in the M.R.P. There are no outstanding amendments; therefore, existing plans should be complete and updated with the addition of the enclosed information;

(1) The name and address of the permittee is shown in Section 2.2.1 (p. 2-1) of the M.R.P.; The permit number is ACT/007/022, as shown in Section 2.6 (p. 2-16) of the M.R.P. The requested term of permit renewal is 5 years, as described in Section 2.6 (p. 2-17) of the M.R.P.; There have been no major changes in the original approved permit - minor changes or amendments have been placed into the permit on an on-going, as-approved basis;

(2) A copy of the newspaper notice and proof of publication is shown in Figure 2-3 (p. 2-26) of the M. R. P.; A subsequent public notice for Determination of Completeness is shown in Figure 2-4, (p. 2-27) of the M.R.P. A proposed new Public Notice for Permit Renewal is attached to this application - this is a new Figure 2-3 and should replace the existing Figure 2-3 (p.2-26) the M.R.P.

(3) An insurance liability policy is shown as Figure 2-1 (p. 278) of the M.R.P.; an updated policy is attached to this application - this is a new Figure 2-1 and should replace the existing Figure 2-1 (p. 2-18) of the M.R.P.;

(b) Processing and Review

(1) Public notice will be filed in accordance with UMC 786.11(a) - see attached Figure 2-4;

(2) This application for renewal does not extend beyond the boundaries of the existing, approved permit;

(3) N/A - no new land areas are included with this application;

(4) There have been no modifications or amendments to the permit that have required any change in the existing performance bond for the property; however, the existing bond shown in Figure 2-2 (p. 2-21) of the M.R.P. has been replaced with a new bond. A copy of the latest bond is enclosed with this application as Figure 2-2, and should replace the existing Figure 2-2 (p. 2-21) of the M.R.P.

Also enclosed with this application are copies of the most recent monitoring results. The water monitoring should be added to the M.R.P. at the end of Chapter 7 as Appendix 7-1; the vegetation monitoring should be added at the end of Chapter 9 as Appendix 9-1 (if not already done).

Per your request, 8 copies of each of the updated pages or additions are included with this submittal.
