GENERAL COMMENTS:

Mr. Dan Guy accompanied the undersigned inspector on this complete inspection. Site conditions were dry with the exception of several of the ponds and associated diversions. At this time, Beaver Creek Coal Company is preparing for a five year permit renewal for the C. V. Spur.

1. PERMITS:

The associated mine documents were reviewed and found in good order. The 1988 Annual Report has been completed and sent in to the Division.

4b. DIVERSIONS:

All of the undisturbed and disturbed drainage systems (ditches) appeared to be functional and stable. During the inspection, water was observed flowing through the undisturbed area at the northwest corner of the property. Evidently, seepage from the irrigation canal has surfaced on the adjacent lands and was being properly conveyed throughout the undisturbed diversions.

4c. SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS:

1. Ponds 1, 5, 6, and the plant overflow pond contained water; all of the remaining ponds were dry.

2. Pond inspections were performed on March 30, 1989; no associated instability or erosional problems were noted.

4e. SURFACE AND GROUNDWATER MONITORING

1. Monthly monitoring of CV-15-W has been conducted according to the approved plan. Reports indicated that the sample point has been dry (no discharge) throughout the first quarter of 1989.

2. UPDES reports were complete and have been sent; no discharge was indicated on all reports.

7. COAL PROCESSING WASTE

First quarter refuse pile inspection was completed on March 30, 1989. The refuse pile appeared to be well compacted and graded at this time.
