General Comments. A partial inspection of the preparation plant was completed on 2/5/96. Was accompanied on the inspection by Mr Ballard, consultant.

Followup Items. Would recommend that the permittee take the necessary steps to

(1) To install the revised sediment markers covered under last years approved amendment and

(2) Remove the short two post fence north of the railroad tracks adjacent to the soil pile.

Diversions. No runoff was being discharged and conveyed in any of the disturbed or undisturbed ditches. No evidence of prior runoff short circuiting was observed.

Sediment Ponds. Ponds 1, 5, 6 and impoundment 4 contained runoff.

Permanent Truck Dump/Conveyor. Reviewed the permittees permit amendment application for a truck dump & conveyor. A preliminary field review was completed. However, the amendment application is pending comments from the Carbon County Building Department.
