Dear Mr. Sauls:

I am in receipt of your cover letter, mine plan reference and easements, regarding the disposition of Notice of Violation N96-26-3-1. The information clearly indicates easements which do provide right of ingress and egress for installation and maintenance of utilities within your permit area. Based on this information, I am prepared to dismiss the Notice of Violation with the following stipulations:

1. Savage Coal Terminal update their existing Mining and Reclamation Plan to accurately reflect the location of utility installations.
2. Easements referenced by Table 4-1, need to be updated to reflect Savage Industries Inc. as the grantor of ingress and egress to and from the property, and included in the Mining and Reclamation Plan.
3. Reclamation of surface disturbance exceeding the five foot corridor provided for in the right of way easement needs to be accomplished by October 30, 1996.
