




Dear Mr. Malencik:

Savage Industries, Inc. is herein requesting approval to use a portable screening plant to generate approximately 500 tons of stoker coal for a customer. The plant is completely portable and will be supplied by the customer. It will be set up on the coal stockpile area where it will be used for 2 or 3 days and then removed from the site. Our Air Quality Approval Order allows for use of a screen on site.

It is my understanding this is a one-time operation, and that any future specialty coal would be generated by a permanent, permitted system.

Although this is a one-time operation this request is submitted as an amendment to the M.R.P. along with a check list to indicate compliance with the regulations.
