3. TOPSOIL

The topsoil pile had some perennial vegetation on the top and east side but the subsoil pile had almost no desirable vegetation. I suggested to the Operator that an effort should be made to establish vegetation on the subsoil pile. Wood chips and sewage sludge facilities are very close to the site and these resources should be used.

4. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE:

a. **Diversions:** All diversions and culverts observed were functional.

b. **Sediment Ponds:** Pond 6 had been cleaned. The sediment was placed adjacent to the pond until dry enough to transport to the refuse pile.

18. SUPPORT FACILITIES/UTILITY INSTALLATIONS

Mr. Guy had called prior to the inspection to obtain information on removal of the concrete thickener tank. I asked Wayne Western, Division Engineer, what would be needed. He stated that no preapproval is required since removal of the facility is part of the reclamation plan. Mr. Guy stated that the concrete will be taken to a county permitted disposal facility. After the thickener tank is removed the Operator must submit new surface facility maps and update the permit to show removal.
