The Division has determined that the permit renewal application for the Crandall Canyon Mine is "complete and accurate," with the submittal of the current bond and evidence of liability insurance. Violation information was submitted but needs to include a brief description of the violation alleged in the notice (R645-801-113.320). Please submit this information by July 30, 1999.

Publication of the public notice for permit renewal may proceed as required by R645-300-121. The publication should now proceed for four consecutive weeks. At the end of the 30-day comment period, findings for the renewal will be made and the permit renewed unless a factual basis for denial of the renewal is presented to and upheld by the Division.
