Dear Mr. Haddock:

Enclosed are 3 copies of a proposed amendment for the Savage Coal Terminal. This amendment is to allow installation of an additional railroad crossing and culvert to reduce loader travel between the coal storage areas. A similar crossing was permitted and constructed to the east of this proposed crossing, to allow better equipment access to the fuel station. This crossing will further reduce loader travel and potential dust emissions by allowing better access to coal piles north and south of the railroad.


The proposed culvert will be the same as that previously installed in the crossing below. The existing culvert was sized and approved adequate for the design runoff for the railroad ditch CD-10. Since this proposed culvert is in the same ditch and located upstream of the other, no new sizing calculations should be required. The new culvert has been designated C-26, and design specifications have been added to Table 7-25.

The proposed location of the crossing is shown on the enclosed Plate 3-2. Required C₁/C₂ Forms are also enclosed.
