Dear Mr. Jensen:

I am responding to your request for a Department of the Army permit for the Savage Coal Stockpile project. This project is located in Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, Carbon County, Utah.

Based on the information you have provided, the proposed discharge of dredged or fill material into 0.05 acres of wetlands is authorized by Nationwide Permit Number 21. However, the work must meet the terms and conditions listed on the enclosed nationwide permit information sheets. **Upon completion of the work authorized by this permit, the permittee must sign and return the enclosed compliance certification as required by General Condition 14.**

This verification is valid for a period of two years from the date of this letter or until the nationwide permit is modified or expires, whichever comes first. This nationwide permit is currently scheduled to expire on March 18, 2007.
