Dear Daron:

Enclosed are 3 copies of an updated Surface Facilities Map for the Savage Coal Terminal, showing a small area to be redesignated as a Coal Storage Area instead of an Equipment Storage Area.

The Coal Storage Area is located just west of Sediment Pond #6, in a disturbed area which has been used for equipment storage and pond cleaning access.

The Equipment Storage Area will be more consolidated in the area to the north of the stockpile area as shown on the map. The equipment and stockpile areas will be separated by the existing plant drainfield, which will be fenced for protection.

This amendment will allow for storage of plant feed coal closer to the plant. There are no changes to existing drainage, and all activity is on previously disturbed area.




