NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N06-46-3-1

"Conducting Mining Activities Without DOGM Approval"

Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of violation

- 1) Conducting mining activities prior to receiving proper DOGM approvals to conduct these activities.
- 2) Excavating and forming conveyor support footings for conveyors #1 b (BC-02) and #1 d (BC-03) without DOGM authorization.

Provisions of act, regulations or permit violated

- 1) ~~R~~ R645-300.142, Conducting all coal mining and reclamation operations only as described in the approved application.
- 2) UCA 40-10-9; Permit Required

Portion of operation to which notice applies

- 1) Footings which were being prepared for concrete pours for proposed conveyors #1 b, and #1 d. Both are adjacent to the Savage Coal Terminal wash plant building.

Remedial action required (including any interim steps)

- 1) The Permittee must salvage and store any soil material recovered from the #1 b and #1 d footer excavations. Material is to be used in settling basin berm construction.
- 2) The Permittee may proceed with concrete pours for footers @ #1 b and #1 d.

Abatement time (including interim steps)

- 1) Soil recovery and storage to be completed by 7/28/2006 @ 17:00 Hours.
