Hello Mr. Nielsen,

I did a little bit of checking into how to properly dispose of the Russian Olive and Tamerisk trees that are on the property. I called Ron Patterson, the agricultural specialist in Carbon County. He told me that you are permitted to burn the trees as long as you contact the Price police department (dispatch number) and get permission to do it beforehand. You'll want to chop up the trees as much as you can prior to burning them.

He also directed me to a publication on invasive Russian Olive trees and how to deal with them:
