Hi, April:

I just talked to Garth about the wells. I'll get an amendment together, along with an updated map for the new well. We plan on leaving S-2-GW in place also, so the amendment will include the original 2 wells along with the new one. At this point, we don't plan on doing any additional oil and grease monitoring on the active wells - we haven't seen a problem in some time. We will continue to monitor them in accordance with the permit. The new well will be checked (and monitored) at least quarterly for 2 years, and bi-annually thereafter. Baseline sampling on all sites will also be taken in 2013, as required. I plan to have the amendment in by July 16. Let me know if you have any questions.
