4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions


Spring maintenance on the diversions is in progress. Several diversions have already been cleaned and re-groomed. Plans are to go through all of the diversions as part of the spring cleaning. A picture was taken of one of the diversions that has been maintained and is attached to the PDF version of this inspection report.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

Several of the sediment ponds are slated to be cleaned this spring as part of the spring cleaning of the entire site. The pond by the crude oil load out and one of the ponds off from the preparation plant are currently designated.

Noncoal waste is being controlled on the site according to the approved plan.
