The Savage Coal Terminal is an operating coal loadout where coal is crushed, screened, blended, and then loaded onto rail or truck transport. Pertinent water monitoring requirement information is in the MRP in Section 731.200 (Vol. 2, pg.116).

## Springs

*The Permittee is not required to monitor any springs at the Savage Coal Terminal because there are no springs at the site.*

## Streams

*Surface water site CV-14-W is required to be monitored during the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of each year.*

## Wells

*There are two groundwater monitoring wells at the site, S-1-GW and S-3-GW and a French Drain CV-1-W. These sites are monitored bi-annually during the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of each year.*

## UPDES

There is one active UPDES outfall at the Savage Coal Terminal, CV-15-W, or UTG040005-001.
