2. Signs and Markers

The identification signs are placed at two separate entrance points leading into the permit area. Both of these signs contain the name, address, phone number and Utah Permit number. The signs are in compliance with the Utah Coal Rules.

3. Topsoil

Topsoil protection is provided by vegetation, earthen berm and a silt fence structure on the west side. The silt fence is being used as a wind barrier to prevent coal fines from accumulating on the pile.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Diversions throughout the site are open and functional.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The embankments of the sediment ponds on site are all stable. The pond used for discharge 006 is full of water.

5. Explosives

There are no explosives on site.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile sign is in place and meets the requirements.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

Roadways are well graded and are watered periodically for dust suppression.
