

Dear Mr. Hedberg:

This letter is to request that Andalex Resources be granted a modification to the sedimentation pond inspection procedure currently in force at the Wildcat Loadout facility. At the moment, Andalex inspects the ponds on a weekly basis and we would like to have this changed to a quarterly basis. These ponds have been in place at Wildcat now for over two years, and to date there have been no problems with any of the ponds nor has there ever been a discharge from any of the ponds. The ponds are under constant surveillance by persons responsible for the inspections by virtue of the fact that they are not remote or poorly visible. Therefore, if any problem with any of the ponds were to occur between inspections it would be observed immediately and addressed.

Based on these considerations, we would appreciate the Divisions acceptance of this proposal.
