Re: PAP Amendment, Sediment Pond Inspection Frequency Change,
Andalex Resources, Inc., Wildcat Loadout Facility,
PRO/007/033-87A, Folder #2 & 6, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed its review of your August 13, 1987 deficiency response. Our June 6, 1987 review letter identified technical concerns which needed to be addressed before we could consider approving the request to amend the weekly sediment pond inspection frequency at the Wildcat Loadout facility.

Andalex proposes to utilize "boney" for riprap protection at the pond inlets. Before the Division can consider approving this proposal, the operator must provide documentation as to the adequacy of the riprap material (see June 6, 1987 letter to Andalex Resources). Riprap must meet the specifications of UMC 817.72(b)(1)(4). If possible, please provide the requested information by September 30, 1987. Thank you for your cooperation in completing this permitting action.

Please contact James Fricke, Division Hydrologist, should you have any questions concerning the technical requirements of this review.
