Synopsis

On November 16, 1988 I sampled the accumulated sediments in Pond B, the main coal storage pile and its coal-soil interface, and the coal-soil interface of the Stoker Coal Storage Pad. The purpose of this sampling was to determine the acid forming potential of the coal and boney material on site.

Analysis and Recommendations

Laboratory analyses from Inter-Mountain Laboratories, Inc., of Sheridan, Wyoming received on December 19, 1988 (letter attached) of Acid-Base Potential indicate no acid forming potential for the material sampled. However, analyses of samples collected by Andalex have yet to be submitted.

Based on the results of these analyses, the Division will make a determination as to the acid-forming potential of coal material at the Wildcat Loadout.
