The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has completed a review of the Permit Application Package (PAP) for the Andalex Resources, Inc. (Andalex) Wildcat Loadout site. The Division has determined the plan to be apparently complete. In compliance with R624-1G-786.11(b) and (c) of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UMC, Section 40-10-1 et seq.), notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies having a jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the operations that a complete plan is available for public review.

The Wildcat Loadout, which has been in operation since April 1985, is located approximately three miles west of U.S. Highway 6 on the Consumers Road near the town of Helper, in Carbon County, Utah. The permit area is located on the Standardville Quadrangle U.S. Geological 7.5 minute maps.
