

Re: Wildcat Loadout Permit Stipulation

Dear *Rick* Smith,

I have enclosed for your review and inclusion into our permit, information which is necessary to address the stipulations associated with our Wildcat permit (PRO 007/033).

First, regarding 817.22-1 and 817.23-1, the reader is now referred to Appendix D for a summary of seed bed preparation, monitoring and success standards for both the revegetation test areas and the topsoil piles.

Second, it is Andalex's intention to complete the work on sedimentation pond E by July 14, 1989 (817.46-1).

Third, chapter IV has been revised sufficiently to describe methods for disposal and timetables regarding acid and/or toxic forming materials, should any be encountered (817.48-1).

Last, Andalex has committed in the PAP to perform alternative 1 pertaining to wildlife enhancement during 1989 (817.97-1).

I am confident that this information will adequately address your stipulations. Thank you.
