Stipulation UMC 817.22-(1)-(HS) and UMC 817.23-(1)-(HS) were satisfied by the commitments on replacement pages 79-80 and Appendix D.

Stipulation UMC 817.48-(1)-(HS) addressed on replacement pages 141-142 is insufficient to satisfy the above stipulation. The operator must commit to burying or otherwise treating all acid-forming or toxic-forming materials within 30 days after they are first exposed on site.
