The mid-term review for the Wildcat Loadout Facility is completed. Several issues were reviewed for the mid-term. The Certificate of Insurance was updated in July, 1991 to incorporate updated language. The spillway and decants on the permanent impoundment were revised in July, 1991 and the final as-builts were submitted and approved December 3, 1991. Andalex Resources, Inc., also updated the entire Permit Application Package for the Western Technical Center of the Office of Surface Mining in October, 1991.

A 510 (c) check was made on November 19, 1991 and no problems were noted.

Synopsis

The following technical deficiencies were formulated subsequent to a cursory review of the Permit Application Package (PAP). Particular deficiencies enumerated below request data and information regarding coal processing waste quality, vegetative success of the revegetation test plots and an updated air quality approval order. Division actions may be required after receipt and review of the requested data and information.

R614-301-233. Topsoil Substitutes and Supplements

The 1990 annual report does not contain laboratory results from the annual "leachate analysis" of coal processing waste and reject material as described in the commitments made on page 23 of the PAP. Please submit omitted laboratory results.

R614-301-233.200

On page 51 of the PAP, the permittee states the following:
"Observations will be made over a minimum two year period to determine the extent of success (of the revegetation test plots) . . ." Please submit results of test plot observations and discuss the results as they relate to demonstrating the suitability of the proposed substitute topsoil material.

R614-301-420. Air Quality

Appendix B contains a letter addressed to Allen D. Emmel (Tower Resources), dated August 31, 1987 from Montie R. Keller of the Utah Bureau of Air Quality. This correspondence refers to an air quality approval order dated January 23, 1987. The Division possesses the approval order of July 22, 1982. Please clarify this discrepancy and submit for inclusion in the PAP, the new and most current air quality approval order.

R614-301-731. General Requirements

Please submit the results of the erosion monitoring (i.e., erosion pins) for the diversion ditches and locations enumerated on page 129A of the PAP.
