


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

Dear Mr. Kelley:

Enclosed please find material adaptable to our mining and reclamation plan which addresses the above referenced violation, parts 1-of-3 and 2-of-3 (part 3-of-3 has been terminated). Essentially, this text and map addresses topsoil contamination from wind-carried coal fines and wind-carried coal fines off of the disturbed area. Andalex proposes to clean as many of the fines as is practical with a vacuum system. Andalex also intends to install additional drift-fences while, at the same time, expanding the disturbed area to the BLM right-of-way boundary so that the affected area will become part of the disturbed area subject to final reclamation. Also, it is Andalex's intent to move the affected topsoil piles away from the wind-carried coal fines as part of our overall Wildcat Expansion Plan, submitted March 25, 1994.
