3. Topsoil -

The topsoil piles will be moved in the near future to prevent additional contamination of coal fines to the piles. This action will abate an outstanding NOV.

4a. Diversions -

The diversions throughout the site were inspected and no ditches were out of compliance. There has not been any moisture (rainfall) for several weeks.

4b. Sediment Ponds -

All sediment ponds were dry. There were no signs of erosion of the inlets, outlets or embankments.

4c. Other Sediment Control Measures -


The loadout uses straw bales for controlling sediment in there ASCA areas. The straw bales have been maintained to the required performance standards.
