With regard to the referenced four-part ten-day notice, received at the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining office on March 18, 1994, I offer the following response:

Part 1: Addresses failure to provide a map which accurately shows water conveyance structures, Plates 1 and 2 of the Wildcat Loadout permit application, regulation R645-301-731.700 and 731.720. The permittee, Andalex Resources, Inc., ACT/007/033, submitted for review and approval on March 24, 1994, Amendment No. ACT/007/033-94A with copies of revised Plates 1, 2 and 5 pertaining to the surface facilities and drainage at the Wildcat Loadout (see attached cover letter dated 3/23/94). The Division anticipates completing the review of the amendment received within the 10-day response period on or about April 25, 1994.

Parts 2, 3, 4: A copy of notice of violation N94-34-1-3 addresses the maintenance of diversions, protection of topsoil and distribution of coal fines outside the permit area.
