1. PERMIT -

- a) The coal loadout expansion project is nearing completion. Operator will be taking samples of fill material for acid and toxic substances.
- b) The insurance accord form was reviewed, meeting compliance, and expires on July 1, 1995.
- c) The mining and reclamation plan was compared with the PFO copy. The two copies were identical with the exception of three maps not yet updated at the PFO.
- d) The refuse pile is non-existent because the material was used as fill for the new coal storage pad.

3. TOPSOIL PILES -

The new topsoil pile was stable with no signs of erosion seen at this time. The new pile has been seeded.

4a. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions were spot-checked with several ditches being cleaned out. Several other ditches were inaccessible due to wet and muddy conditions. Spring clean-out will continue when ground conditions permit.

b. SEDIMENT PONDS -

The Sediment Ponds were not discharging during the inspection. Some of the ponds did contain a small amount of water. No signs of hazardous conditions were noticed.


21. BONDING -

The bond has not been changed since the addition of the coal storage facility. It has been determined by the Salt Lake DOGM that there is currently sufficient bonding.
