1. PERMIT -

A) Andalex is proceeding with the loadout facility expansion project. All sediment control measures are in place with updated maps being submitted to the division.

B) The abatement of the CO 94-39-1-1 has been postponed due to weather conditions. Presently the ground is saturated and snow covered, thus impossible to proceed with the required work. Boulder removal and mulching are still required before termination of the CO.

4a. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS - SEDIMENT PONDS -

The diversions were covered with snow but showed no sign of water leaving the disturbed or permit area.

Sediment ponds B and D were cleaned out prior to the recent snow storm.

7. REFUSE PILES -

The refuse is being used as fill material for the expansion project. The use of refuse material has been approved by the division.
