**1. PERMIT -**

The permittee, PFO, and Salt Lake did a side-by-side of the Mining and Reclamation Plan. Maps and plans were up-dated at the site or will be sent. Plans will then all be identical.

**4A. DIVERSIONS -**

The diversions throughout the property were spot-checked. The diversions were functioning as designed. There were no signs of excessive sediment build-up or breaching of the ditches. The diversions contained no water.

**4B. SEDIMENT PONDS -**

The sediment ponds were inspected with no hazardous conditions being noticed. The ponds were not discharging during the inspection and contained no water. This is a very dry site and highly unlikely to discharge water. There were no signs of erosion of inlets, outlets or embankments.

**4C. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES -**

The permittee uses straw bales for alternate sediment control measures. The straw bales were spot-checked and appeared to be functioning as designed.
