




Dear Mr. Glasson:

The permit renewal application for your permit is due to the Division 120 days prior to the expiration of your permit, on January 5, 1999. The permit expires on May 5, 1999. Verification of bonding and insurance as well as updates to legal and financial information and violation information must be submitted. The application will be reviewed for completeness and you will be notified of the "Determination of Completeness", so that you can move forward and make public notification at that time.

Additionally, the Division is requiring a system which provides for electronic submittal of hydrologic data prior to the permit renewal. The Division had earlier requested that hydrologic data be submitted in an electronic format starting October 1998. By this letter we are notifying you that for each permit renewal, electronic submittal of hydrologic data will be a permit requirement.
