Dear Mr. Glasson:

On April 23, 1999, the Division received a WordPerfect document containing hydrologic data for the Wildcat Loadout Facility. The document lists four sites that are included in the Wildcat Loadout operational monitoring plan. Your data indicated that no flow has occurred at any site during any quarter of 1998. Unfortunately, the information you submitted is inadequate. No sample dates or times are given. No sampler name is given and no field data is provided.

Review of the water monitoring data at the Wildcat Loadout Facility indicates that no samples have been collected at this loadout since 1989. Sampling has not occurred during times of runoff in the past. Andalex Resources, Inc. should make a diligent attempt sample collection to collect water samples during periods when runoff is occurring. The month of April 1999 was a record wet month for much of the State of Utah and sampling at the Wildcat Loadout Facility should have occurred during this wet season.
