

Dear Ms. Littig,

This letter is to respectfully request an extension to reply to the Division's request for additional information relative to the above-referenced Division Order. During the transition from ANDALEX to UtahAmerican Energy we have unfortunately fallen behind on some of our responses to agencies and we are currently making every effort to catch up.

For your information, we are moving forward with our Right-of Way expansion at Wildcat Loadout in an effort to address the Division Order and in fact have had on-site scoping meetings with both the BLM and with EIS who is preparing the Environmental Analysis (EA) in response to the BLM's NEPA requirements. Both the draft EA and the archaeological reconnaissance report are expected to be completed by October 20th and will be submitted to the BLM.

Meanwhile, there are also other very specific issues which UtahAmerican must address to fully respond to your deficiency letter and we expect to be able to respond fully to those questions by October 31, 2006.
