

9. Protection of Fish, Wildlife and Related Environmental Issues

The Permittee has scraped the coal fines off the acreage east of the main stockpile area and north and south of pond "B". The Permittee must stabilize this ground by discing and seeding the area with the interim seed mix proposed within the Division Order response received in July 2010. This action must be completed within 60 days (November 1, 2010) to avoid a compliance action.

13. Revegetation

The Permittee has been instructed to disc and seed the acreage associated with the removal of coal fines from the east side of the permit area.

15. Cessation of Operations

The current Permittee intends to transfer the ownership of the Wildcat Loadout to the Intermountain Power Agency / Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.

18. Support Facilities, Utility Installations

The high voltage power to the site is to be disconnected on August 31, 2010.

19. AVS Check

An update of the ownership and control information for UtahAmerican Energy remains pending within the Division.

22. Other

The east side truck dump and grizzly had been blocked off with Jersey barriers.
