Hi Lance,

I got your message. Sorry I missed your call. It seems like I've been on the phone all day. If I heard you correctly, we're looking at 67 acres of currently approved disturbed/bonded area with a proposed addition of 23 acres of newly disturbed/bonded area. Am I tracking that correctly?

If that's the case, Kit is right in that we'd be looking at a significant revision. R645-303-224.100 states, "An increase in the size of the surface or subsurface disturbed area in an amount of 15 percent, or greater, than the disturbed area under the approved permit" would trigger a significant revision. Significant revisions do require a public notice/comment period.

The rules require that the public notice ad run for 4 consecutive weeks with the 30 day comment period beginning the last day of publication. That said, you could mention that in the request for extending the NOV.

Give me a call tomorrow and we can discuss it more if you'd like. Unless there's an exemption to going the significant revision route that I'm not aware of (please chime in Daron if there is), we'll have to go that route. It's not a huge deal, but it does take more time.
