Analysis:

Information received from the Division's GIS analyst on January 26, 2015 indicated that there were errors on Plate 16, Wildcat Loadout Ownership information, as well as errors in the legal description contained in Chapter 1, page 1-10 under "portions of". In a meeting with John Pappas, Environmental Engineer with the Permittee on February 9, 2015, the "errors" on page 1-10 were discussed. Plate 1-16 was also discussed, with that error being the darkness of the disturbed area boundary lines highlighting PR-1, the primary coal truck access road on the east side of the permit area. A revised Plate 1-16 was received on March 12, 2015. Mr. Pappas also provided an AutoCAD map of Plate 1-16, indicating that the legal description on page 1-10 WAS Correct. The submitted Plate 1-16 received on 3/12/2015 is P.E. certified by Mr. J. Tom Paluso, in accordance with the requirement of R645-301-512.120. Plate 1-16 received on 3/12/2015 as part of the Task ID # 4803 amendment properly shows PR-1 as being within the Wildcat disturbed area. Task # 4803 should be approved as submitted.
