1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

The Division is waiting on Permittee response to the mid-term review.

2. Signs and Markers

I inspected the identification sign and it meets the requirements of the R645 Coal Rules. The sign has all the required information. See Photo

3. Topsoil

I inspected the topsoil piles and I did not see any signs of wind or water erosion. The topsoil piles appear to be stable and protected by a berm. See Photo

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

I inspected the diversions and culverts throughout the property. Some of the diversions and culverts have some sediment build-up within. They are still functioning as designed but spring maintenance will be needed in the near future. Permittee plans on cleaning the diversions and culvert soon.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

All sediment ponds did contain water but were not discharging. It is unlikely that they will discharge. Embankments, inlets, and outlets, were stable. No hazardous conditions were noticed.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

Wattles were inspected and comply with the requirement of the R645 Coal Rules.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

I inspected the refuse pile and it appears to be stable. I did not notice any hazardous conditions to the embankments. The refuse pile has been inactive for several years. See Photos

8. Noncoal Waste

The property was clear of non-coal waste materials such as oil, trash and grease cans.

15. Cessation of Operations

The loadout is considered in temporary cessation.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

The roads were compacted with no dust control problem. The roads were wet and muddy from the melting snow.

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16.b Roads: Drainage Controls

I inspected the road diversions and culverts throughout the property. They were functioning as designed. Some of the diversions have some sediment build-up within. Diversions will need cleaning out in the near future. See Photos.
























TOP SOIL STORAGE
