1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

There are no permitting actions with the Division at this time.

2. Signs and Markers

The identification sign was inspected and it meets the requirements of the R645 Coal Rules. See Photo

3. Topsoil

I inspected the topsoil pile. There were no signs of wind or water erosion. See Photo

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

I inspected all diversions and culverts throughout the property. The diversions and culverts need maintenance due to sediment deposit from the melting snow. Permittee has stated that maintenance will be done on all diversions and culverts. The diversions and culverts were open and could convey water to the sediment ponds during a storm event.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The two sediment ponds at the coal yard have the inlets eroded from the melting snow. These inlets have been repair 3-4 times last year due to rainstorms. The ground is sandy, making it easy for erosion to occur. I believe a design change is needed to prevent this from reoccurring from every rainstorm or spring snow melt. See Photo

Permittee has stated that the inlets will be repair. Inlets can still function, conveying water to the sediment ponds.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

I walk around the refuse pile. The diversions around the pile need some maintenance. Sediment has started to fill in the diversion. The pile has been idle for approximately 20 years. The permittee has occasionally clean areas of coal fines and put the material on the refuse pile.

8. Noncoal Waste

There is some non-coal waste material on the coal side that needs to be gathered.

10. Slides and Other Damage

No slides or other damage was notice during the inspection. The Loadout appears to be stable.

15. Cessation of Operations

The loadout is currently idle. There are plans to re-open this facility in the near future.
