Loadout, ACT/007/034, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has reviewed Soldier Creek Coal Company's response to permit stipulations for the Banning Loadout, received November 28, 1988.

Stipulations UMC 817.43-(1)-MMD and UMC 817.53-(1)-RPS have been found to be no longer applicable, based upon site conditions and the response submitted. Responses and commitments made to the remainder of the stipulations are adequate. However, until the Division has received final as-built and certified drawings and these as well as the stipulation responses and commitments have been incorporated into the appropriate sections of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP), no formal sign-off for the stipulations will be given.

Please submit fourteen (14) copies of text and maps approximately formatted for insertion into the MRP, by February 3, 1989.
