Re: Updating Legal and Financial Section of ORP, Soldier Creek Coal Company, Banning Siding, ACT/007/034, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

During the recent inspection of Banning Loadout, it was noticed that there may be a few discrepancies in your Operation and Reclamation Plan (ORP) for that site. Owners or controllers of Soldier Creek Coal Company seem to be different in the Banning ORP than those listed in the Soldier Canyon Mining and Reclamation Plan. Since the Soldier Canyon plan is a more recent document it is thought that the Banning Siding list may be out of date.

Would you please check your records and make any corrections necessary to bring both plans up to date. Changes should be submitted, by October 9, 1992, as an amendment to the plan and should be in a format readily insertable to the plan. Ultimately the two Soldier Creek plans should correlate.
