3. Topsoil -

The different segments of the test plot all have native vegetation and the test plants appear to be eliminated. The plots with the manure have the highest percent of vegetative cover.

4a. Diversions -

The diversions were functioning and were maintained with no signs of erosion. Silt fences were installed in design drainage as a result of a TDN.

4b. Sediment Pond and Impoundments -

The sediment pond had the inslope raked to eliminate small rills from winter runoff. The pond contained a small amount of water.


