Division Order 92-A regarding updated designs for roads and coal fines has been submitted and approved by the Division. The operator has submitted additional copies for the PAP for the Banning Loadout facility.

2. Signs and Markers -

The signs at the entrance to the property are correct with no change occurring with the sale of the property.

4b. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments -

The sediment pond was partially filled with water and snow. The pond is far from discharging. There are signs of erosion appearing on the inslopes of the pond. The operator is aware of the potential problem and will correct it when weather conditions permit.


