Re: Determination of Completeness for Publication, Permit Renewal Application, Soldier Creek Coal Company, Banning Siding Loadout, ACT/007/034, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has conducted an Initial Review on your application for permit renewal received on June 21, 1993. The information has been found to be adequate to determine the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) complete for publication purposes.

A technical review of the application and plan has been initiated. Technical deficiencies will be forwarded to you as individual reviews are completed. The Division will coordinate with other agencies and incorporate their comments into our review process. Issues raised will need to be resolved prior to permit issuance.

At this time you should publish a Notice of Application for Permit Renewal as required by R645-300-121. A copy of the publication notice should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. You should also insure that a copy of the complete application is on file at the Carbon County Courthouse. The Division will notify all other interested agencies and allow for their comment prior to making a final decision to approve or disapprove the renewal application. You should also submit 12 copies of your reformatted plan for distribution to other agencies as soon as possible.
