

Re: ASCA/Exempt Areas Amendment, Banning Loadout

In the Division approval letter of October 4, 1994 three conditions were attached to the approval. The following is our response to these conditions.

1. ASCA #1: Install (and denote on Exhibit 7-1), the silt fence on both sides of the emergency spillway rather than across it.

Response: Silt fences were installed on both sides of the emergency spillway. Map D 371 has been changed to show both silt fences.

2. Eliminate all reference to straw bales and silt fences as "Siltation Structures" and refer to them as "Sediment Control Measures".

Response: References to strawbales and silt fences has been moved to "Sediment Control Measures". The section on "Siltation Structures has been completely revised to only include the one sedimentation pond.

3. Delete the reference to straw bales and silt fences as "Other Treatment Facilities".

Response: The section on "Other Treatment Facilities" has been revised and now shows that these are "No" other treatment facilities.
