Dear Ms Grubaugh-Littig:

In response to your facimile request of September 15, 1994, we reviewed all the available information concerning Utah Fuel Companys' "rebuttable presumption" language contained in Item 4, and its response, of their letter to your office of August 30, 1994. Upon completion of our review, it is our opinion that all presumed ownership/control relationships should be disclosed in all permit applications regardless of the language in the settlement agreement.

The settlement agreements referred to in the response to Item 4 is an agreement which concerns only the violation issue and does not adress the "presumption of control". Disclosure of any association with a violation through a presumption of ownership/control is required on any/all applications for permits. If a violation has been settled, this will allow for issuance of a permit, but full disclosure of the association is still required.

If the applicant or its owners/controllers wish to rebut the presumption of control concerning the two bond forfeitures in Virginia and the bond forfeiture in Kentucky, they should call or write the following individuals:
