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Enclosed are DOGM forms C1 and C2 and the necessary information required by these forms for a permit change at the Banning Loadout. This permit change is to eliminate a small retention basin just south of the sedimentation pond. This retention basin did not meet the requirement of DOGM R645-Coal Mining Rules.

The small berm that creates this basin will be leveled out and a silt fence will be installed to treat the runoff. The area will be classified as an ASCA area.

We have also classified the area around the substation as an exempt area. We have enclosed runoff calculations for both area.

The disturbance created by removing the berm will be sealed with the approved seed mix.


