Recent updates to the Reclamation Plan for the Banning Siding Loadout have prompted a review of the bond for the site. ORDER & FINDINGS
of
PERMIT DEFICIENCY

PURSUANT to R645-303-212, the DIVISION ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Soldier Creek Coal Company, to make the permit changes enumerated in the findings of permit deficiency in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. These findings of permit deficiency are to be remedied in accordance with R645-303-220.

FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY

The Division finds the permit deficient in that: (1) The currently posted bond, in the amount of \$211,000.00, is not adequate to cover the reclamation costs escalated until the end of the permit term. The bond must be increased to at least \$311,275.00 (1998 dollars). (R645-301-830.300)


Requirements

The permittee must post the revised reclamation amount of \$311,275.00 (1998 dollars).

ORDER

Soldier Creek Coal Company (Permittee) is ordered to make the requisite permit changes in accordance with R645-303-220 and post the revised amount of \$311,275.00 within sixty (60) days of the date of this order.
